2024 marks the fourth year of our Strategic Plan for 2021-2025, which prioritizes racial equity to fulfill our mission. We believe that systemic oppression continues to create barriers that limit access and result in unequal outcomes for Black, Indigenous, and People of Color. We believe we have a responsibility to address these inequities and uphold our values as an antiracist organization while we continue to expand access to bicycles, skill-building, employment, and leadership opportunities in our community.

In addition to our bicycle access and education programming, our plans for the coming year include:

- Annual Bikecitement! celebration and fundraising event in April, 2024 (350 attendees);
- Vibrant and engaging quarterly group community rides (75-200 attendees per ride);
- Paid apprenticeship opportunities for youth in all departments at Bike Works;
- Individual and group volunteer opportunities, which power our bike giveaways;
- Community partnerships that leverage bike education and access in our community;
- Our annual Sponsor Equity Cohort, an honest and challenging community of learning.

## WE INVITE SPONSORS TO DISCOVER A SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENT LEVEL FOR YOU

### **\$50,000** *Sponsorship*

**\$50,000** could help us grow our capacity and provide meaningful employment by adding an additional part-time position on staff.

### **\$25,000** *Sponsorship*

**\$25,000** could support free bike repair services all summer long for community members in Southeast Seattle with the BikeMobile.

### **\$10,000** *Sponsorship*

**\$10,000** could support one cohort of youth apprentices gaining valuable work experience and earning a paycheck at Bike Works.

### **\$5,000** *Sponsorship*

**\$5,000** could support one cohort of our BIPOC Leadership Cohort, facilitating reflection and conversation about race and social justice for high school students of color while learning mechanics and riding bikes.

**\$2,500** could provide five scholarships for our Earn-a-Bike course. Youth hone their bike mechanic skills while working on two bikes: one to take home and one to give away.

**\$1,000** could provide a bike, a helmet, a lock, and lights for 4 people who cannot afford a bike of their own through our Bikes-for-All program, providing healthy, reliable, sustainable mobility.
